Subject: Reminder of Qualifications and Officiating Levels

Dear All,

Please find, outlined below, a clarification of qualifications and officiating levels for Level 1 referees as outlined in the NRAS Policy and Operational Manual:

Level 1

Once qualified, the Referee/Match Official can be appointed to any matches – except representative matches, according to their Level 1 designation – i.e.

Level 1 Mini/Mod:	To matches 6-12 years.
Level 1 International:	To matches 13-19 years.
Level 1:	To Mini/Mod/International matches to 19 years.
Level 1 School teachers:	To any school matches.
Level 1 Student-Referees:	Years 9/10 Mini/Mod – to any primary school matches.
	Years 11/12 Mini/Mod/International to any school matches to years 9/10.
	International – to secondary school matches to years 9/10
Level 1 Touch Judge:	To any matches in that capacity only.
