

MATCH OFFICIAL COACHING SCHEME – LEVEL 2



Level 2

Entry Criteria

Endorsement by local Association that the applicant has performed satisfactorily as a level 1 coach. This endorsement to be on the formal application form downloadable from the ARLRA website.

A Level 2 CMO candidate must have at least two (2) years active experience as a Level 1 CMO.

Payment of the prescribed fee for courses attended after 1 November 2002. That fee is currently set at \$50 for the Level 2 course.

Content

This level is almost entirely practical and interactive. The initial session will involve the participants making a presentation to the group incorporating what they gained from the previous course, what they incorporated into their coaching/training and generally their modus operandi in their home Groups/Associations.

The participants are then asked to report on a game. It may be a television game, or ideally a video of a match viewed on (say) the Friday night of a 2 day course. From this report, we do the following.

- Analyse each participant's evaluation report on the match official by creating overheads of the reports and asking the applicant to present and explain each area of the report. At the end of the session, the presenter will explain HIS/HER report and highlight any differences in attitude and evaluation.
- Incorporated into this session are the vital areas of what to include (good and bad) and what to ignore. What to leave for another day. The most important aspects for the match official to take from his/her game. Note: the difference between evaluating the match official for appointment and for coaching purposes.
- Each applicant will participate in a role-play of a counselling session which will be viewed and analysed by the presenter and his/her peers. The session should be video taped to enable the applicant to see what everyone else has seen.
- Specific paper on touch judge performance and appraisal.
- The applicants will develop a 12 month business plan for use in their respective districts. To be posted to the presenter on return to their homes.

On receipt of the business plan and the satisfactory completion of the weekend's work, applicants may be granted the Level 2 registration.
