Off Field Referee Attire

1. OBJECTIVE

To provide policy and procedures to implement a National standard uniform for off field referee attire for Rugby League Referees throughout Australia.

2. SCOPE

Appropriate attire is required by Rugby League Referees to carry out their duties before and after a Rugby League match.

The attire may incorporate the Australian Rugby League Referees Association Inc. logo.

The use of the off field attire is at an individual Association discretion.

3. PROCEDURES

Off field attire for Rugby League Referees that may be required to fulfil their duties, should comprise of:-

- appropriate dress shirt
 - a) polo shirt ; and/or
 - b) short/long sleeved collared shirt
- appropriate trouser, slacks, or shorts and skirts.
- appropriate track suit
- appropriate blazer, jumper, vest or jacket
- appropriate footwear
- appropriate head wear
- tie
- hose

Off field attire should be of a neat, tidy and respectable appearance and standard at all times.
