Off Field Ancillary Equipment

1. OBJECTIVE

To provide policy and procedures to implement a National standard of off field referee ancillary equipment for Rugby League Referees in Australia.

2. SCOPE

Ancillary equipment is required by Rugby League Referees to carry out their duties before and after a Rugby League match.

It should be current and reviewed on an Annual basis, or as required.

This equipment may incorporate the Australian Rugby League Referees Association Inc. logo.

The use of the logo is at the discretion of a State or an affiliated Association.

3. PROCEDURES

Ancillary off field equipment for a Rugby League Referees official that may be required to fulfil their duties, should comprise of:-

- appropriate referee bag
- boot bag
- Handbook or Association literature that may be available
- applicable NRAS Handbooks
- report sheets
- stationary
- Australian Rugby League Laws of the Game rule books - current editions.
